



Government Degree College (Autonomous), Nagari successfully organized a **Financial Literacy Awareness Programme** under the guidance of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), in collaboration with Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam and in association with the Association of Mutual Funds in India (AMFI).

As part of this initiative, the college facilitated student registration for the **SEBI Investor Awareness Certification Test** and conducted the online examination strictly as per official guidelines. The examination was held on **23rd and 24th February 2026**, covering **350 students** in six batches. The test was conducted online without formal coaching or training sessions, ensuring an unbiased assessment of students' financial awareness.

The entire programme was coordinated by **Dr. P. Venugopal, Associate Professor, Department of Commerce**, who is a **Financial Literacy Certified Master Trainer** under the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) initiative.
