
The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 11.11.2024, attaching therewith the D.O. letter No.138/2020-WW dated 28.10.2024 of the Secretary, Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD), has communicated that every year, the period from 25th November 2024 (International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women) to 10th December 2024 (Human Rights Day) is observed throughout the world as 16 days of Activism for ending gender-based violence. The campaign symbolically links violence against women with the issue of human rights and emphasizes that such violence is a violation of human rights. Therefore, MWCD has requested to conduct programs highlighting initiatives of Government in combating gender-based violence and raising awareness about the rights and entitlement of women. The suggestive activities, inter alia, may include:

- Raise awareness on Emergency Response (112), Women Helpline (181) and Child line (1098) for quick access to services.
- Awareness on filing Domestic Incident Report (DIR) under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act and complaints on SHe-Box under SH Act.
- Conduct workshops and seminars to raise awareness on 'the Domestic Violence Act 2005', 'The Sexual Harassment Act 2013', 'POCSO Act 2012', 'Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023', and special rights under 'Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023' including Victim Compensation etc.
- Enhance awareness on confidential reporting through the SHe Box portal and get redressal effectively.
- Conduct workshops aimed at teachers and students to educate them about gender equality, consent, good touch-bad touch, healthy relationships, upholding dignity of women and girls and respectful behaviour.
- Plan and launch an effective social media campaign using hashtags and informative content to raise awareness about women's rights.
- Host Webinar on prohibition of Child Marriage, Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace and Prevention of Domestic Violence.

Report : A counseling session on **sanitary pad disposal** was conducted on **3rd February 2025** at **GDC (A), Nagari**, with the participation of **55 girl students**. The session aimed to raise awareness about proper disposal methods and their importance for personal and environmental hygiene.

The program began with an **introductory speech** by the faculty, highlighting the need for menstrual hygiene education. A **health expert** was invited to provide detailed guidance on the **safe disposal of sanitary pads**, including the following key points:

- **Avoid Flushing:** Flushing pads leads to plumbing blockages and environmental hazards.
- **Use Disposal Bins:** Always wrap the used pad in newspaper and dispose of it in designated bins.
- **Incineration Method:** Burning pads in designated incinerators to reduce waste.
- **Eco-friendly Options:** Use biodegradable pads or menstrual cups to reduce waste.
- **Community Responsibility:** Encourage peers to follow hygienic disposal practices.

A **demonstration** was given on **hygienic disposal** and students actively participated in the discussion. They shared their doubts and received clarifications on menstrual hygiene myths and taboos.

The session concluded with a **pledge** to follow and promote safe sanitary pad disposal practices. Feedback from students was positive, with many expressing their interest in further menstrual hygiene awareness programs.

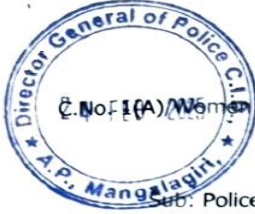
